\* Any Act by Senior. Student that prevents disrupts or disturbs The Regular. academic Ac tivity of Any other student or a fresher

\* Exploiting The Services of a fresher or Any other Student for Completing the academic tasks assi gned to an Individual or a group of Students



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## Actions To be Taken on those Students Who Indulge in Ragging

Every Single Incident of Ragging a First Information Report (FIR) Will be filed without Exception by The Institutional authorities with The local police Authorities

Depending upon The nature and The gravity of The offence as Established The possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging shall be Any one or Any Combination of the following

- \* Cancellation of Admission
- \* Suspension from attending The classes.
- \* Debarring from appearing in Any Test / Examination or other evaluation process.
- \* Suspension / Expulsion from The hostel
- \* Restiction from the institution for period from 1 to 4 Semesters
- \* Expulsion from The Institution And Consequent debarring from Admission to Any other Institution



  
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## Anti ragging

Ragging is a disturbing reality in the Higher Education.

Anti ragging A step towards a Positive and safe Educational Environment.

Ragging a term commonly used to describe the act of initiation or harassment of newcomers in educational institution, has been a long-standing problem in many countries. It often involves physical mental, or emotional abuse, creating an atmosphere of fear and insecurity. However in recent years, there has been a growing awareness about the negative effects of ragging and a collective effort to stamp it out. This essay will discuss the importance of anti ragging initiatives.

And the measures institutions can take to create positive and safe educational environment for all students. firstly, it is essential to recognize the impact of ragging on the victims. many students who undergo ragging experience a decline in their mental health and academic performance. The constant fear of bullying and humiliation can lead to anxiety depression, and even, suicide in extreme cases.



  
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## Ragging prohibition prevention punishment

The university grants commission vide its letter no F-16/2007 (CPP-II) dated June 17 2009 has reiterated the ban on ragging of student in Institution of Higher Learning.

Punishment for participation in or Abetment of Ragging.

- 1) Cancellation of admission
- 2) suspension from attending classes.
- 3) withholding results.
- 4) fine up to Rs 25000/-
- 5) Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution
- 6) Restriction from the institution for periods varying from 1 to 4 semesters or equivalent period.

## Affidavit by student and parent

Each student and his/her parents/guardian shall have to furnish an affidavit along with the application from the effect that they will not participate in shall be liable for punishment under the penal law of India.



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
